Tips for smarter and faster play

Decide any team games and “investments” before your actual tee time.

If you have the honour, tee off then mark your card.

Play your shot if safe then help look for a lost ball.

Play when ready if safe unless in a match play competition.

Park your buggy around the green with the shortest path to the next tee.

Line up your putt while the player furtherest from the pin makes her/his putt.

Putt out if sensible to do so.

Move to the next tee immediately the last putt is sunk.

Keep your sand bucket loaded so you can immediately repair divots.

A minute saved per hole is 18 minutes per round
